My Dog Just Ate His Own...

Many dogs engage in stooleating behavior, also known as coprophagy. While the explanations for it are just as varied as the treatments, we know one thing for sure: it's gross.

Whats in Your Dog's Food?

Ethoxyquin is a preservative found in many dog foods, particularly those containing fish meal. It is also used as a pesticide, marketed under the name "Stop-Scald."

Eating If you look at the back of your bag of food, you will rarely ever see Ethoxyquin listed as an ingredient. Why? Because if it is used on the protein source prior to entering the dog food plant, then they are not required to list it as an ingredient. *They* did not add it, so they do not have to list it.

Ethoxyquin was introduced to the pet food industry in the 1960s—about the same time that many in the veterinary field noted a shift from communicable diseases to chronic diseases. It has since been banned from human

consumption, except in the use of some spices, such as paprika, to aid in color retention.

So what's bad about ethoxyquin? Not only has it never been proven to be safe, but it has also been linked to thyroid, kidney, reproductive and immune related illnesses, as well as cancer.

While it is relatively safe in trace amounts, ethoxyquin accumulates in the system over long-term use. It is this build up that has been correlated with diseases and death.

To find out if this ingredient is in your pets food, please email rebecca@beaufortdog.com. I have contacted many of the most common companies, and while some informed me that this information was proprietary, others were very forthcoming that their food does *not* contain this preservative.
